7. General Business:

- a. The email regarding the ICV issue for an Elfin was discussed. The Elfin was on full registration, did not have an exemption certificate and was not classed as an ICV so will now have to wait for the 25 years rule for conditional registration.
 - If clubs have requests for ICVs etc on conditional registration their Constitution should have a "and other vehicles" clause.
- b. The AHMF Annual General Meeting will be held in September in Adelaide. The interstate members have requested Sarah Clark (DIT) as a guest speaker to discuss the SA Grant Scheme, our Conditional Registration Scheme, ICVs and electric drive conversions. It is possible that the Transport Minister will open the conference. The President thanked the committee for all their help in organizing this.
- c. The MX5 query was discussed. If the vehicle comes from interstate or overseas and has a current registration and is the same owner not a problem. If a new owner it must go to Regency Park for a ID check.
- d. MR334 books are sent to the clubs not the authorized person involved and the forms can be signed by any authorized person. If an authorized person is no longer authorised, their MR334 book does not have to been returned to DIT and can be used and signed by any other authorised person.
- e. A discussion if a vehicle can be on conditional registration if a Family Trust is involved. No form of registration can be carried out with a Family Trust or any other form of Trust. However incorporated bodies are allowed such as incorporated clubs, government such as CFS, councils etc provided they are financial members.
- f. What will happen to the petrol tax now that Electric vehicles are in?
- g. With the announcement that the bus (Queen of the Desert) is to be restored will the Federation give a donation? The President will look into this.
- h. When a club has organized a National event in SA it would be great if numbers, days, costs etc be given to the Federation so that when we have a meeting with DIT it would be good to give that information.
- i. The new Code of Practice will be handed out to delegates only that are present here.

 A reminder that the Code of Practice advises all aspects of the club registration scheme.
- j. A reminder that if a club has a new committee that the club makes sure the new committee is up to date with the Code of Practice.
- k. A reminder that if a club updates their Constitution that, when it has been accepted by Consumer Affairs, a copy must be sent to the Federation and the D.I.T.
