This is a scheme dated 1 September 2020, is limited to a value of \$10,000 and will expire on 30 June 2021 and is in accordance with Clause 10.2 of the Constitution.

Guidelines for the Application for a Grant

- 1. The Federation may approve a grant of up to \$500.00 to a financial member of the Federation for a motoring event that complies with the following conditions:
 - Is in accordance with the objects of the Federation,
 - Is not a sporting/competitive/commercial event,
 - Is an open event not restricted to the membership of the requesting club
 - Is to be held in South Australia.
- 2. The request for a grant shall be on club letterhead and signed by either the club President or Secretary of the organising club or the Chairman of the organising committee.
- 3. The grant must be used for a specified purpose of the motoring event, and not used to subsidize any entry fee or purchase of_rally bag contents.
- 4. Examples of specified purposes may include but are not restricted to:
 - Hire of Oval
 - Hire of Hall
 - Hire of Marquees
 - Hire of tables and chairs
 - Printing of Programmes
 - Council approval and council permit expenses.
- 5. In approving a grant to a member club, the Federation reserves the right to refuse or vary any request. Copies of invoices or quotes will assist in the approval process. Clubs may only seek one grant within the above period.
- 6. Requests for a grant with supporting documents to be made at least 3 months prior to the event to

- 7. Clubs are asked to supply their banking details (BSB and Account Number) for electronic funds transfer to their club. Transfer of a Grant will occur on receipt of written approval by the SA Government for the event to proceed.
